More is not necessarily better. 16 and 24 bulb tanning beds are the norm, although some beds can go up to as many as 48 bulbs. The bulb strength for tanning beds varies. A bed can have bulbs of different strengths for different parts of the body, or only one strength for all the bulbs.
